Positive Behaviour for Learning, known as PBL is a whole school program that actively promotes positive behaviour. It supports students in early childhood years through to upper primary years of schooling. PBL is a data driven program. A PBL committee meets on a fortnightly basis to organise the implementation of PBL and review school data.
